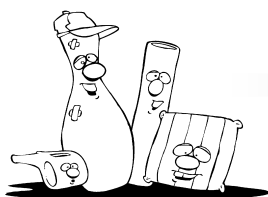

Get off to a great start by attending training for coaches. Your team will receive **5 bonus points** if the team coach attends training. You'll also be the first to know about game changes and rule changes.

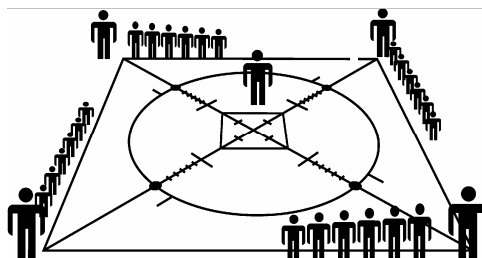

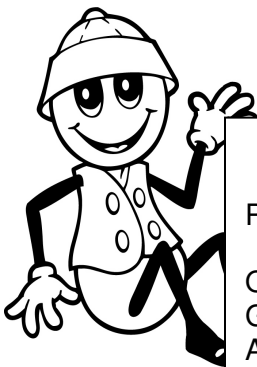
